Izzy Pirate Doll



Materials:

Lion Brand Vanna's Choice: Honey, Dusty Purple, Pink, Chocolate, Terracotta, small amounts of Black, Toffee, and White for the eyes.

Red Heart with Love: Daffodil for earrings and pixie dust pouch

Crochet Hook Size F - 3.75mm

Crochet Hook Size E - 3.5mm (for eyes only)

Tapestry needle for sewing

Polyester Fiberfill for stuffing

Terms and abbreviations to know:

Magic ring

Rnd - round

ch, chs - chain, chains

sk - skip

st, sts - stitch, stitches

sc - single crochet

hdc - half double crochet

dc - double crochet

inc - increase, 2 sts into one sts

sctog - single crochet together, decrease

inv - invisible

invsc2tog - invisible single crochet 2 together; this is essentially a decrease, but done in such a way as to make the continuous stitching smoother, and the decrease not as noticeable.

1. Insert hook into front loop only of next stitch, DO NOT yarn over.
2. Insert hook into front loop of second stitch.
3. Yarn over. Pull through 2 loops.
4. Yarn over and pull through last loop.

dc bobble:

1. Yarn over, and insert hook into designated st.
2. Pull up a loop.
3. Yarn over, and pull through 2 loops, leaving 2 loops left on hook.
4. Yarn over, and insert hook into same st.

5. Pull up a loop.
6. Yarn over, and pull through 2 loops, leaving 3 loops left on hook.
7. Yarn over, and insert hook into same st.
8. Pull up a loop.
9. Yarn over, and pull through 2 loops.
10. Yarn over, and pull through all 4 loops on hook.

Notes: Know how to crochet in rnds. This pattern is worked from the feet up, with no joining. Use a st marker as you work to mark the beginning of each rnd. The boots are made separately, so we will be starting the pattern with bare feet. As a free pattern, this pattern has not been tested, but is accurate to the best of my abilities. Please let me know if you find any errors!

Legs, Make 2, fasten off after the first, to start the second. Do NOT fasten off after the second leg, so that you can continue on with the body. Starting with the feet in Honey. Begin with a magic ring.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring; 6 sts

Rnd 2: inc in each st around; 12 sts

Rnd 3: (sc, inc) 6x; 18 sts

Rnd 4: (sc in next 2 sts, inc) 6x; 24 sts

Rnd 5: (sc in next 3 sts, inc) 6x; 30 sts

Rnd 6: sc in next 10 sts, invsc2tog 5 times, sc in next 10 sts; 25 sts

Rnd 7: sc in next 7 sts, invsc2tog 5 times, sc in next 8 sts; 20 sts

Rnd 8: invsc2tog, sc in next 16 sts, invsc2tog; 18 sts

Rnd 9: sc around; 18 sts

Rnd 10: sc in next 7 sts, invsc2tog 2 times, sc in next 7 sts; 16 sts

Rnd 11-12: sc around; 16 sts

Switch to Dusty Purple

Rnd 13-30: sc around; 16 sts

Stuff each of the legs before moving onto the body.

Don't fasten off after the second leg. Continue on.

Body still in Dusty Purple

Rnd 31: To join the legs, sc in next 8 sts on the current leg (this is the right leg of doll), join with a sc to the opposite leg in the 3rd st from where you fastened it off, sc in next 15 sts around the leg, join up to the next unworked st of the right leg, and complete the round with sc in each of the last 8 sts; 32 sts

Rnd 32: inc, sc in next 14 sts, inc, sc in next 16 sts; 34 sts

Use the loose purple end from the left leg to sew up the gap between the legs.

Rnd 33: inc, sc in next 16 sts, inc, sc in next 16 sts; 36 sts

Rnd 34-38: sc in each st around; 36 sts

Fasten off the Dusty Purple and attach Pink.

Rnd 39: sc in each st around; 36 sts

Rnd 40: BLO sc in each st around; 36 sts (leaving the front loops to work on the bottom of the t-shirt later)

Rnd 41-42: sc in each st around; 36 sts

Rnd 43: sc in next st, invsc2tog, sc in next 16 sts, invsc2tog, sc in next 15 sts; 34 sts

Rnd 44: sc in next st, invsc2tog, sc in next 15 sts, invsc2tog, sc in next 14 sts; 32 sts

Rnd 45-50: sc in each st around; 32 sts

Rnd 51: sc in next st, (ch 8, sk next 3 sts), sc in next 13 sts, repeat (), sc in next 12 sts; 16 chs, 26 sts

Rnd 52: sc in next st, (sc in next 3 chs, inc in next 2 chs, sc in next 3 chs), sc in next 13 sts, repeat (), sc in next 12 sts; 46 sts

Rnd 53-54: sc in each st around; 46 sts

Rnd 55: (invsc2tog, sc in next 8 sts, invsc2tog, sc in next 11 sts) 2x; 42 sts

Rnd 56: (sc in next 5 sts, invsc2tog) 6x; 36 sts

We will be doing some color changes in the next couple rnds, to emphasize the V-neck in her shirt.

Rnd 57: (sc in next 4 sts, invsc2tog) 5x, sc 1 in Pink, sc 1 in Honey, sc in next 2 in Pink, invsc2tog in Pink; 30 sts

Rnd 58: (sc in next 3 sts, invsc2tog) 5x, at the end of last dec, pull through Honey and complete the rnd in Honey, sc in next 3 sts, invsc2tog; 24 sts Cut and fasten off Pink.

Continue in Honey for the head.

Rnd 59: (sc in next 2 sts, invsc2tog) 6x; 18 sts

Rnd 60-61: sc in each st around; 18 sts

Rnd 62: (sc in next 2 sts, inc) 6x; 24 sts

Rnd 63: (sc in next 3 sts, inc) 6x; 30 sts

Rnd 64: (sc in next 4 sts, inc) 6x; 36 sts

Rnd 65: (sc in next 5 sts, inc) 6x; 42 sts

Rnd 66: (sc in next 6 sts, inc) 6x; 48 sts

Rnd 67: (sc in next 7 sts, inc) 6x; 54 sts

Rnds 68-77: sc in each st around; 54 sts

Rnd 78: (sc in next 7 sts, invsc2tog) 6x; 48 sts

Rnd 79: (sc in next 6 sts, invsc2tog) 6x; 42 sts

Rnd 80: (sc in next 5 sts, invsc2tog) 6x; 36 sts

Rnd 81: (sc in next 4 sts, invsc2tog) 6x; 30 sts

Stop here to embroider the nose on. Using the same Honey color, cut a string from the end of your skein, and embroider the nose in the center of the face, over rnd 70. Stuff head firmly, and continue on to close up head. We will be sewing on the eyes, after.

Rnd 82: (sc in next 3 sts, invsc2tog) 6x; 24 sts

Rnd 83: (sc in next 2 sts; invsc2tog) 6x; 18 sts

Rnd 84: (sc in next st; invsc2tog) 6x; 12 sts

Rnd 85: (sc in next st; invsc2tog) 4x; 8 sts

Fasten off and weave tail in around the hole to pull closed.

Eyes, using smaller hook size, E and black, brown, and white yarn

Begin in black with magic ring.

Rnd 1: 4 sc in magic ring, join with sl st to first sc by pulling brown through for the sl st; 4 sts. Drop black yarn, but do NOT cut. You will be picking it back up in rnd 4.

Rnd 2: ch 1, inc in each st around, beginning with the same st as sl st, join with sl st to first sc by pulling white through for the sl st; 8 sts. Drop and cut brown.

Rnd 3: ch 2, (hdc, sc) in same st as sl st, (sc in next st, inc in next st) 2x, sc in next st (sc, hdc) in next st, leave last st unworked and fasten off white, leaving a tail for some sewing; 11 sts

Rnd 4: pick up black yarn at the beginning of rnd 3, through the first hdc. ch 1, do NOT sc in the same st you pulled through, sc in next 10 sts; 10 sts. Cut black yarn, but leave a long tail for sewing and adding eyelashes.

*Refer to pictures on the blog for more detailed instructions about sewing on the eyes.

Optional Mouth: You can leave doll without a mouth, or embroider a simple mouth in black, just below the nose, as pictured. I did this before sewing on the bandanna, so that I could pull the loose ends up to the top of the head and knot them off there, and they'd be hidden under the cap.

Ruffles on the bottom of the shirt: in Pink

This is easier to do BEFORE adding the arms.

Hold your doll with the head pointed toward your chin, and work sts through the unworked front loops of rnd 39. Begin with the first st of the rnd, on the right side of the doll, and work around;

Rnd 1: attach pink to first unworked st of rnd 39 with sl st, (sk next 2 sts, [sc, hdc, dc] in next st, [dc, hdc, sc] in next st) 9x, sl st to join and fasten off; 27 sts **Important note:**

The final [dc, hdc, sc] will be made in the same st as first sl st where Pink was attached. This will make the transition smoother. When joining with the final sl st, make it underneath the first ruffle to hide it, then weave in ends securely.

Arms beginning with Honey, make 2

Arms will be made in two parts, first the shoulder socket, and then the arm. The arm will then be sewn onto the socket, and the socket onto the shoulder. This is to get the look of her rounded shoulders.

Socket in Pink, make 2

Begin with magic ring.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring; 6 sts

Rnd 2: (inc in next st, sc in next st) 3x; 9 sts

Rnd 3: (inc in next st, sc in next 2 sts) 3x; 12 sts

Rnd 4: (inc in next st, sc in next 3 sts) 3x; 15 sts

Rnd 5-6: sc in each st around; 15 sts

Begin with magic ring.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring; 6 sts

Rnd 2: sc in each st around; 6 sts

Rnd 3: (inc, sc in next 2 sts) 2x; 8 sts

Rnd 4-5: sc in each st around; 8 sts

Rnd 6: inc in next st, dc bobble in next st (thumb), sc in next 6 sts; 9 sts

Rnd 7-17: sc in each st around; 9 sts

Rnd 18: (inc, sc in next 2 sts) 3x; 12 sts

Rnd 19-21: sc in each st around; 12 sts

Fasten off, and attach Pink.

Rnd 22: in Pink, sc in each st around; 12 sts

Rnd 23: BLO, sc in each st around, sl st into first st of rnd; 12 sts

Rnd 24: ch 1 and turn and turn arm around so that you are working DOWN the arm, through the unworked front loops of rnd 22, (3 hdc in next st, sl st in next st) 6x, sl st under the first ruffle, to hide the joining; 24 sts

Bandanna and Hair: using Pink Grapefruit for bandanna and Chocolate for hair.

Begin with Rose

Begin with magic ring.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring; 6 sts

Rnd 2: inc in each st around; 12 sts

Rnd 3: (inc, sc in next st) 6x; 18 sts

Rnd 4: (inc, sc in next 2 sts) 6x; 24 sts

Rnd 5: (inc, sc in next 3 sts) 6x; 30 sts

Rnd 6: (inc, sc in next 4 sts) 6x; 36 sts

Rnd 7: (inc, sc in next 5 sts) 6x; 42 sts

Rnd 8: (inc, sc in next 6 sts) 6x; 48 sts

Rnd 9: (inc, sc in next 7 sts) 6x; 54 sts

Rnd 10-17: sc in each st around; 54 sts

At the end of rnd 17, attach Chocolate.

Row 1: sc in next 25 sts, sl st in next st; 26 sts (including the sl st)

Row 2: ch 1 and turn, sk sl st, sl st in next 2 sts; sc in next 3 sts, hdc in next 15 sts, sc in next 3 sts, sl st last 2 sts; 25 sts

Row 3: ch 1 and turn, sk first sl st, sl st in next st, sc in next 4 sts, hdc in next 14 sts, sc in next 4 sts, sl st in last st; 24 sts Fasten off, leave long tail of both Pink Grapefruit and Chocolate, for sewing onto head.

Bandanna Ties: Pink Grapefruit

Ch 41

Rnd 1: *sl st in first 2 chs, sc in next 3 chs, hdc in next 4 chs, dc in next 5 chs, hdc in next 2 chs, sc in next 9 chs, hdc in next 2 chs, dc in next 5 chs, hdc in next 4 chs, sc in next 3 chs, sl st in last 2 chs.* Turn work so that you are working all of the next sts into the unworked bottom of the chs, repeat from * to *

Fasten off, and tie it into a knot in the center. Then weave in your ends, and sew the center knot to the back center of the bandanna cap.

Sew the bandanna to her head, leaving a little bit of space above the eyes.

Hair wisps (bangs): Chocolate

This is made in such a way that both wisps can be made on 1 ch with the right side facing for sewing on.

Ch 19

Row 1: sl st in first ch, sc in next ch, (hdc dec) 2x, sc in next 3 chs, 3 sc in next ch, sl st in next 2 chs, sc in next 2 chs, hdc in next ch, 2 hdc in next ch, sc in next ch, sl st in last ch.

Sew above her right eye, part to her head, and part to the bandanna.

Pig Tails: Make 2 in Chocolate and Terracotta

With Chocolate first, begin with magic ring.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring; 6 sts

Rnd 2: sc in each st around; 6 sts

Rnd 3: inc in next 2 st, sc in next 4 sts; 8 sts

Rnd 4: sc in next st, inc in next 2 sts, sc in next 5 sts; 10 sts

Rnd 5: sc in next 2 sts, inc in next 2 sts, sc in next 6 sts; 12 sts

Rnd 6: sc in next 2 sts, inc in next 4 sts, sc in next 6 sts; 16 sts

Rnd 7: sc in next 5 sts; inc in next 2 sts, sc in next 9 sts; 18 sts

Rnd 8-10: sc in each st around; 18 sts

Rnd 11: (invsc2tog, sc in next st) 6x; 12 sts

Rnd 12: sc in each st around; 12 sts

Cut off Chocolate and attach Terracotta

Rnd 13: (invsc2tog, sc in next st) 4x; 8 sts

Rnd 14: (inc, sc in next st) 4x; 12 sts

Rnd 15: sc in each st around; 12 sts

Rnd 16: (invsc2tog, sc in next st) 4x; 8 sts

Rnd 17: (inc, sc in next st) 4x; 12 sts

Rnd 18: (inc, sc in next 2 sts) 4x; 16 sts

Rnd 19: sc in each st around; 16 sts

Rnd 20: (invsc2tog) 8x; 8 sts

Fasten off, leaving long tail for sewing. Sew the pigtails into place in the back side, onto the hair in the back of her head.

Ears/Earrings: Honey for the ears, Daffodil for the earrings. Use whatever yellow yarn you have on hand.

I didn't do the ears until this point of the pattern because I needed to make sure they had a place, and would look right. This way, with everything else sewn on already, you can make sure they are evenly stitched on the sides of her head.

For ears:

With Honey, Ch 4

sc in first ch, inc in next ch, (sc, sl st) in last ch; 5 sts

Fasten off.

For earrings:

With Daffodil, ch 3, sl st into bottom of the ear, fold it over, and sew it to itself through to the back of the ear. Knot off, and weave all ends carefully through the ear, and then around the top of the head, under the cap.

Add a little bit of blush to her cheeks, just above the corners of her mouth, with a small make-up brush and blush! I keep a Dollar Tree brand of blush around here just for my doll making!

Boots in Terracotta, make 2

Begin with magic ring.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring; 6 sts

Rnd 2: (inc, sc in next st) 3x; 9 sts

Rnd 3: sc in each st around; 9 sts

Rnd 4: (inc, sc in next 2 sts) 3x; 12 sts

Rnd 5: (inc, sc in next 3 sts) 3x; 15 sts

Rnd 6: (inc, sc in next 4 sts) 3x; 18 sts

Rnd 7: (inc, sc in next 5 sts) 3x; 21 sts

Rnd 8: (inc, sc in next 6 sts) 3x; 24 sts

Rnd 9: sc in each st around; 24 sts

Working in turning rows now, instead of rnds, do not join at the end of each row. You will be leaving an open space we will sew some later.

Row 1: ch 1 and turn, sc in each of the next 23 sts, leaving last st unworked; 23 sts

Row 2-10: ch 1 and turn, sc in each st across; 23 sts

At the end of row 10, turn the heel inside out, and sl st end together to close the back of the boot. Fasten off. Back to working in rnds.

Rnd 1: reattach Terracotta to the back of the heel, and sc 24 evenly around, do not join; 24 sts

Rnd 2-5: sc in each st around; 24 sts

Rnd 6: (inc, sc in next 7 sts) 3x; 27 sts

Rnd 7: (inc, sc in next 8 sts) 3x; 30 sts

Rnd 8: (inc, sc in next 9 sts) 3x; 33 sts

Rnd 9: (inc, sc in next 10 sts) 3x; 36 sts

Rnd 10-17: sc in each st around; 36 sts

Rnd 18: (invsc2tog, sc in next 10 sts) 3x; 33 sts

Fasten off, and weave in all your loose ends. Just fold the top down for the look, and the back has a natural heel!

Pixie Dust Pouch and Necklace: Daffodil, or whatever yellow you have. Chocolate for the chain.

Beginning with Daffodil, start with a magic ring.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in magic ring; 6 sts

Rnd 2: inc in each st around; 12 sts

Rnd 3: (inc, sc in next st) 6x; 18 sts

Rnd 4-6: sc in each st around; 18 sts

Rnd 7: (invsc2tog, ch 1, sk next st) 6x, join with sl st in first st; 6 sts and 6 ch 1 spaces

Rnd 8: (sl st into next ch 1 space, ch 2, 3 hdc in same ch 1 space) 6x, join with sl st and fasten off. Weave in ends.

For the chain, using Chocolate.

Ch 55, fasten off.

Weave the ch in and through the ch 1 spaces left in the pouch. Pull so that the ends are even. Here you can either connect it with your loose ends and weave them into the ch,

leave them open for tying on, or (what I did), use this [video](#) to create a magic knot which doesn't leave any ends! Just get the knot as close to the chain as possible.
